DAY KIDDUSH

STEP-BY-STEP:

- 1. Make sure the challahs on the table are covered
- Fill your Kiddush cup with wine or grape juice (some have the custom for the cup to overflow)
- 3. Hold the cup in your dominant hand
- 4. Have everyone at the table in mind
- 5. Start with the blessing of Mizmor L'David
- 6. Everyone responds L'chayim to the leader's Savri Maranan
- 7. Continue with the final blessing
- 8. Everyone else should answer "Amen"
- 9. Sit down and drink majority of the wine
- 10. Top up your Kiddush cup with more wine if necessary to mix it with the original wine
- 11. Pour into cups and distribute to everyone at the table

DAY KIDDUSH

A psalm of David. The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He refreshes my soul. He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake. Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You set a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup is filled to overflowing. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath Day and declared it holy.
